RULES AND REGULATIONS

- ❖ The Tournament is open to Tamil Nadu Players only.
 - ❖ The Latest FIDE Rules in force shall apply and the Swiss system will be followed.
 - ❖ Time Control : Each Half an hour.
 - ❖ Tiebreak : Buchholz tiebreak system will be applied in case of tie, prizes will not be shared.
 - ❖ Participation certificates will be awarded to all participants.
 - ❖ The Chief Arbiters' decisions' shall be final and binding on all players concerned.
 - ❖ **An entry fee of Rs. 500/- per player is to be paid in Cash (or) Demand Draft.**
 - ❖ **Entries close at 5 P.M. on 28-08-2024. Strictly no Spot Entry.**
 - ❖ Birth Certificate should be brought as a proof of age.
 - ❖ A school giving maximum number of entries will be appreciated with a Trophy.
- The TNSCA / CDCA / organizer reserve the right of admission to the venue.

Special Concession

- ❖ TNSCA player registration for the year 2024 - 25 is compulsory for all the players. Players who have paid the TNSCA Player registration earlier in other tournaments, must bring the proof. Players who have not paid the fees before, must pay the fee of 150/- through this link : <https://registration.tamilchess.com/new-register/>
- ❖ Chennai District Player Registration fee of Rs. 75/- for the year 2024 - 2025 only for all Chennai District Players.
- ❖ There will be **50% concession (Rs.250)** for the students of JGVV group of schools subject to their proof of identity. However they should also register with TNSCA for the year 2024 - 25 by paying **Rs.150/-** (If not registered)
- ❖ **Food** : Food can be had in the canteen on payment.
- ❖ **Accommodation** : Outstation players will have to make their own boarding and lodging arrangements.
